- The arrangement conference should be limited to as few people as possible in the arrangement office with telephone and email being used whenever possible.
- Visitations and funeral services within our funeral homes during Phase 3 will be limited to gatherings not to **exceed 75% occupancy**, while maintaining social distancing. Since each funeral home has a different maximum occupancy amount, please check with your funeral director to see what that number will be.
- The scheduling of services outside the funeral home will be at the discretion of the church and clergy.
- Graveside services will be at the discretion of the Cemetery.
- The use of funeral limousines will continue to be discontinued at this time.
- No outside food or beverage will be allowed within the funeral homes.
